OTHER DUTIES TO BE DONE

*Firemen:*The Firemen are responsible for starting the fire(s) required by the patrol for the meals specified. They are also responsible for fire safety, directing the gathering of firewood, and when necessary, putting the campfire(s) out.

*Cooking:*The names listed under cooking are responsible for all phases of meal preparation and cleanup of the kitchen immediate kitchen area, being sure to clean all surfaces with the appropriate, measures, delivering dirty pots and pans to the KP area, and making sure that adequate measures are taken to preserve foodstuffs after usage.

*KP:*The term KP means Kitchen Patrol. The names listed under KP are responsible for all phases of cleanup after the meal has been served. This means heating enough water to properly clean dishes, cleaning all dishes, both personal and patrol, drying those dishes and ensuring that they are returned to their proper locations.

Water: The names listed under Water are responsible for ensuring that adequate and safe water supplies are maintained for their patrol, at all times. Persons having Water detail at lunch should be sure to gather enough water to last through the afternoon.

*Firewood:*The names listed under Firewood are responsible for gathering all fire starting materials necessary for the Firemen to start the fire and keep it going for the period detailed.

Other Duties: Those names listed under other duties are responsible, usually for just one time occurrence, for the designated duty. If you have the duty to build the gate, you are responsible to make sure that the gate gets built, as well as dismantling it when the event is over. If you build the firepit, you are responsible for disbersing the pit and making sure that no sign remains of it when the event is over.
